work. It seems likely he got the idea of Elves from the North Country (the Noldor) from reading Finnish mythology. This same mythology is the source for material about the Elves of Maahilund in the second book of J. Ellyne's The Fair and Fey series. Finnish mythology is full of tales about Elves called the Maahiset who live in an underground city in ancient Finland and have magical powers. What if Middle Earth later became known as Germania after the Elves left Middle Earth and sailed into the West (Britannia)?
